#### 7. Treasurer's Report – Rosa York

- a. June 2017 Beginning balance as of 06/01/2017 was \$42,814.42. Total income was \$15565.38, total expenses were \$7617.94, with an ending balance of \$50,761.86 as of 06/30/2017.
- b. July 2017 Beginning balance as of 07/01/2017 was \$50,761.86. Total income was \$110.00, total expenses were \$3679.02, with an ending balance of \$47,192.84, as of 07/31/2017.
- c. August 2017 Beginning balance as of 08/01/2017 was \$47,192.84. Total income was \$8427.23, total expenses were \$5850.91, with an ending balance of \$49,769.16, as of 08/31/2017.

#### 8. Budget Amendments

Rosa York moved to add a line item for "First Grade ELA Kits", Bethany Hammonds seconded. Motion passes unanimously.

Rosa York moved to remove any references to "Not PTA Funds" in the Escrow Income/Expense section of the 17-18 Budget, Kara Cubbage seconded. Rosa presented discussion that these funds are still PTA funds held in escrow. Motion passes unanimously.

Rosa York moved to rename the line item "Teacher Appreciation" in the Special Days section of the 17-18 Budget to "Teacher Hospitality", Mansi Shah seconded. Rosa presented discussion that this line item is designated for teacher birthdays, breakfasts etc and not associated with Teacher Appreciation Week. Motion passes unanimously.

Rosa York moved to rename the line item "IB Enrichment/Teachers Training" in the School Improve/Curriculum Enhance section for the 17-18 Budget to "Principal/Teacher Training, Ms Kim seconded. Motion passes unanimously.

Rosa York moved to decrease the line item "New Teachers Supplies" to \$300 and "Returning Teacher Supplies to \$1750 in the School Improve/Curriculum Enhance section and move the excess \$250 to "First Grade ELA Kits" line item, Bea Gunz seconded. Motion passes unanimously

Rosa York moved to decrease the line item "PTA Website" to \$14 and move the excess of \$66 to "First Grade ELA Kits", Resh Basu seconded. Motion passes unanimously.

Rosa York moves to increase "Spelling/Geography Bee" to \$220, Manisha Gupta seconded. Motion passes unanimously.

Rosa York moves to have Bethany Hammonds and Mansi Shah as bank statement reviewers, Kara Cubbage seconded. Motion passes unanimously.
